- ♥ Order books to give as samples

Top 5 Tips

- 1 Good News: It's simple and cheap to publish a book! OK News: It takes time, money, skills to make it look "real".
- 2 Look at lots of books to get ideas.
- 3 It takes longer than you think. Give yourself a reasonable timeframe.
- 4 Plan a Release Party, trip, event to keep you motivated to meet your deadline.
- 5 Get help! Get company! Make work dates with others. Ask for a 2nd set of eyes for computer tasks, research. Outsource any steps that seem hard. Other people will provide soft accountability and make it more fun!
